Once my student is accepted for enrollment, I am responsible for the financial obligation of the entire year. Even if I withdraw my child before the end of the year, I will be responsible for the entire tuition for the year.

However, the teacher and administrators will work with me and my child to resolve any problems so hopefully this will not happen.

## Veritas Classical Schools Code of Conduct

Veritas students are expected to:

1. Honor God, their parents, their instructors, and their fellow students according to biblical principles of conduct.
2. Act respectfully to all students, teachers, staff, and administration. Disrespect in word and /or actions will be dealt with immediately. This includes talking when the teacher is teaching, being disruptive in class, and not following classroom expectations. Inappropriate language is not acceptable.
3. Know and comply with the Veritas dress code that has been established. Failure to comply with the VCS dress code may require students being asked to call their parents for appropriate clothes.
4. Arrive on time and be prepared to participate in class each week.
5. Students are expected to come prepared for class. Work may be turned in late the following week for half credit. All assignments more than one week late will result in a grade of zero. Understanding that there are occasionally extenuating circumstances, students will be allowed to email work to the teacher before midnight two times a semester without any penalty. A printed copy of the work must be turned in to the teacher the following week. Teachers will not make copies of homework that is emailed and will grade only from the hard copy. Students will only receive full credit when the printed copy is submitted. The assignment will receive a grade of zero if the printed copy is not turned by the following week. Work will not be accepted through email after the second time per semester.
6. If a student is absent due to illness or being out of town, please know that it is the student's responsibility to submit all missed work within two weeks of the date assigned. Work submitted after two weeks will not be accepted, and the student will receive a zero for the assignments. No make up work will be accepted at the end of the semester. Please notify teachers of planned absences in advance.
7. Be honest and original in all assignments. Plagiarism or cheating of any kind is not tolerated, and students will receive a zero on the assignment.
8. Cell phones must be turned off and out of sight from arrival to departure. No IPODS, earbuds, head phones, or electronic toys are allowed at Veritas at any time. Students should not use their cell phones to share videos, take pictures, use Snap Chat etc. with other students at any time. If a student wishes to text a parent or look something up, that student should ask for specific permission from the teacher in charge at that time.
9. No toys should be brought to school except for balls for recess, or quiet games for rainy day recess.

## Veritas Classical Schools - Nashville Dress Code for 2023-24

Veritas Classical Schools has a standardized dress code. **The ultimate goal with our dress code is modesty and neatness.** Since the time spent in class is limited, we ask that dress code not become an issue. Please adhere to the requirements stated below.

### SHIRTS

- **Any color solid or striped** classic polo shirt (long or short sleeve) may be worn.
- **Solid, striped or plaid** oxford shirts for boys and **traditional** oxford blouses or 100% cotton cloth blouses for girls are allowed.
- If girls wear a top underneath the polo or blouse, the polo or blouse needs to be buttoned, so that the girls are modest in their appearance. **NO** see through blouses.
- Shirts may not be worn like a jacket but must be buttoned up.
- Flannel may be worn but must not be old and faded.

### PANTS/CAPRIS, SKORTS, SKIRTS, DRESSES, SHORTS:

- modest, traditional pants, knee length shorts or capris (solid color navy, khaki, black, gray, green, white or brown **ONLY**) **Jeans of any color are not acceptable for pants.**
- or a traditional knee-length or longer skirt, jumper, or knee-length skort (solid color navy, khaki, black, gray, green, white or brown **ONLY**) Skirts are to be traditional skirts, not layered skirts or slit skirts, etc.
- **Dresses** may be additional solid colors, such as pink, purple, red, and orange.
- If younger girls wear skirts, it is recommended that they also wear shorts under the skirt.
- Skin tight pants or jeans are not acceptable for girls or guys. **Leggings or jeggings are not acceptable as pants. Solid leggings or jeggings may be worn under a knee length skirt.**

### COATS, JACKETS, SWEATERS:

- Jacket or sweater worn over the polo or oxford shirt may be any color
  - You must have a polo shirt or oxford shirt under your jacket or sweater.
  - Sweat shirts must have a polo worn underneath them.
  - **No hats to be worn in class.**

### SHOES AND ACCESSORIES:

- Shoe color and style is left to the parents' discretion.

### PERSONAL APPEARANCE:

- No earrings for boys. Girls may wear earrings in their ears.
- No nose rings or other piercings
- No unusual hair color is acceptable. (Only natural colors)
- Boys' hair should not be long. It should be cut neatly.
- Students should arrive on campus clean and neat.
