I John Study Guide

Background

First John is written by John, the son of Zebedee. John was an apostle and one of the twelve disciples. Because I John has similar text and vocabulary of John, it is believed that they were written by the same person. This book was written no later than 90 A.D.

Introduction

The theme of I John is the basics of Christian life. He focuses on three: true doctrine, obedient living, and fervent devotion. I John explains all the things that God has done for His people. He sacrificed His only son, Jesus Christ, for our sins. I John 2:8 states, “darkness is passing away... the true light is already shining.” John explains that God’s people can reflect His light by showing love to others. The book explains the importance of loving God instead of things in the world. I John 2:15 says, “Do not love the world or things in the world.” Chapter 2:17, goes on to explain, “...whoever does the will of God abides forever.”
