- Journal:** Using *Your Bible Journal Toolbox* for guidance, write down your thoughts/questions on the assigned passages, using THREE of the five categories. Be prepared to share in class.

History: America: The Last Best Hope

- Prepare** for a test over the first three chapters. The test will be next week, September 14, 2023. Be prepared to identify on a map: The Triangular Trade Route with labeled continents. Use your chapter questions and summaries to aid your preparation for this exam.
- Read Chapter 4, "Reflection and Choice: Framing the Constitution." (1783-1789)
- Answer** the following questions thoroughly on a separate sheet of paper. Bring ALL your questions and answers to class and be prepared to discuss.
 1. What were key weaknesses of the Articles of Confederation?
 2. What were key achievements of the Articles?
 3. How did American traditions of religious freedom begin to take shape during this period? Articles period?
 4. What led to internal discord within the new states during the Articles period?
 5. What key roles did Madison, Washington and Franklin play in the writing of the new Constitution?
 6. What were the basic sections of the new Constitution?
 7. What philosophies lay behind the three branches of government and checks and balances between those branches?
 8. How did the new government differ from that under the Articles?
 9. What compromises did the founders make on slavery? Were they necessary and what was their impact on the future?
 10. The battle over ratification: What key arguments were made by both the Federalists vs. Anti-Federalists?
 11. What were the origins of the Bill of Rights and how crucial was this addition to the ratification of the Constitution?

12. What amendments have been added since the original ten?

- Complete a brief summary; define words that you need to explore further and a timeline of events for EVERY chapter in History. List key players, events and important dates. Use the attached worksheet. Bring your completed summary to class and be ready to participate in class discussion
