Formatting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 12pt, Times New Romans/Arial/Calibri font</li> <li>• Organized into clear, easy to understand sections</li> <li>• Both printed and stapled together, <i>and</i> emailed to Mrs. Kirby</li> </ul>	/10
Background	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Full paragraph with complete sentences</li> <li>• Organized, with proper transitions</li> <li>• Includes: author, date, audience, occasion (the “why” of the letter), and any other pertinent information.</li> </ul>	/15
Introduction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Full paragraph, with complete sentences</li> <li>• Organized, with proper transitions</li> <li>• Includes author’s overall purpose, themes</li> <li>• Suggests things to look for in the letter</li> <li>• Includes student’s own analysis, insights</li> </ul>	/20
Outline	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Proper formatting of Roman Numerals, capital letters, Arabic numerals, lower cases letters, lower case Roman numerals (if needed)</li> <li>• At least three major categories (probably more), with subcategories</li> <li>• Contains independent analysis (how YOU think it should be outlined, not just outside sources)</li> <li>• Accurate to the text</li> </ul>	/15
Chapter Questions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At least two per chapter, for a total of twelve</li> <li>• Open-ended, not just reading comprehension questions</li> <li>• Causes the reader to think, interact with the text</li> <li>• Has a practical element that helps reader to apply text to their own lives</li> </ul>	/20
Answer Key	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Thorough answers to the questions you have written</li> <li>• Complete sentences, with proper punctuation</li> <li>• Contains reflection on text, personal application</li> </ul>	/20
